- 2. Recap from Friends of the Library
 - FOL Book sale will be May 25th from 9:00-2:00. Volunteers to help are very welcome!
 - Finances: Starting balance: \$4048.88. Ending Balance: \$4041.23
- 3. Update from Library Director (Donna Pierce)
- A. Monthly Statistics
 - Total number of library visits for the month of March was 1291, with an average daily library visitor total of 59. There were 18 programs held, with a total program attendance of 203. Total circulation for the month of March was 2143 items. There were 14 new library cards issued this month.
- B. Update on Staffing
 - Ashley Pierson was introduced to the library board. She is replacing Joann Teuscher.
 - City Council approved a new 20 hour position. Both the Mayor and Council member Petersen spoke up in support of this position.
 - Director Pierce spoke to the board about hiring Joy Wear and if they felt she would need to resign her board position or not. As an advisory board there is no conflict of interest.
- C. Program Updates
